

# Competition Rules

All exhibitors are subject to and agree to abide by the rules as below:

- All items must be solely made by the entrant.
- Each entrant is allowed only one entry per class.
- All entrants must agree to collect their exhibits between 2pm and 5pm on the day of the show.
- Any entries not collected will be disposed of at the discretion of the organisers.
- Entry forms must reach the Competition Secretary by **Friday 22nd September**. **No late entries will be accepted.**
- The exhibits will be displayed at the Autumn Show.
- The decision of the Judge is final. He/she has the power to withhold any award if the exhibits are deemed to be unworthy.
- Exhibits and prize cards must **not** be removed until after 2pm on 8th October 2017.
- We will not take responsibility for exhibits after 5pm.
- Any objections must be made in writing to the Competition Secretary before midday on the day of the show, together with a deposit of £5.00 which will be retained if the objection is not upheld.
- Certificates and rosettes will be available from 2pm.

# Classes

Please see back of this schedule for competition rules. Points will be given for taste and appearance. Classes are open to all (with exception of the 12 years and under). You may enter as many classes as you wish but can only submit one entry per class. All entries to be presented on a plain white plate.

## 1. Cheese Scones

Use your own recipe to bake 4 scones of equal size using a 6cm or 2½ inch cutter.

## 2. Artisan Bread

Use any recipe to bake a loaf of bread of your own choice.

## 3. Victoria Sponge

All entries **MUST** use the following recipe and 2 x 7inch or 18cm tins that are at least 1½ inch or 4cm deep.

6oz (175gms) butter  
6oz (175gms) caster sugar  
6oz (175gms) self-raising flour (sieved)  
3 large eggs  
Few drops of vanilla essence

To finish: Raspberry jam filling  
Light sprinkling of caster sugar on top

## 4. Decorated Biscuits - 12 Years and Under

Bake 4 identical decorated biscuits from your own choice of recipe. Exhibitors age is age on the day of the show, 8th October 2017.
